## **CRICKET AT KENT STREET**

The Cricket Program at Kent Street is a fully Approved Specialist Program from the Department of Education and fully endorsed and supported by the WACA.

One of the first secondary schools in Perth and the pioneer of specialist sports programs in WA, Kent Street offer Cricket students a challenging and rewarding program designed to provide a suitable background for students wishing to pursue a career in cricket as well as those with more of a recreational or personal interest.

The Kent Street Cricket program has been a very successful specialist program since 1988. The program has produced numerous A grade cricketers and state representatives and two International Test Players.

## **CRICKET STUDENTS**

Cricket students commute daily from across the metropolitan area, with a number travelling from as far as Wanneroo in the North, Mandurah to the South and Mt. Helena to the East. Bus services to the school are regular and take about 10 minutes from the city centre.

A number of students come from country areas in order to study Cricket and a few from interstate and overseas. Whilst some of these students board with friends or relatives in Perth, the majority stay at the Rotary Residential College which is situated on the school campus and provides high quality student accommodation.

The program is open to both males and females.

## **CRICKET STAFF**

Currently there are three cricket teachers at Kent Street all of whom are qualified Cricket Australia Level 2 coaches. The staff have vast experience in cricket and have been involved in the game for many years.

## **CRICKET FACILITIES**

Students are provided with first class facilities at Kent Street with four hard wicket practice nets and 6 wicket turf cricket block for all matches and practice. We also have access to Harold Rossiter Reserve turf cricket wicket for all matches. A specific cricket room has 15 computers for in depth skill analysis using the SWINGER program.

## **ENROLMENT**

Students wishing to enrol into Cricket at Kent Street should complete the Expression of Interest form at the end of this Prospectus.

## **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

A skills test is held at the WACA on Monday 3 April 2017. Testing can be arranged at other times by contacting the school.

Cricket students complete the National Training package Certificate II in Sport over the two years of Year 11 and 12. They choose other subjects dependent on their vocational direction and tertiary training requirements. The Sports Industries course develops generic skills that lead to TAFE Sport & Recreation Certificate and Diploma courses. This allows students to choose Physical Education and Outdoor Education as courses of study.
